Quality Improvement Plan:

- A Quality Improvement Plan (QIP) is a welldefined intentional plan that identifies an area of improvement within a program and helps clearly define steps and action items that will improve practice.
- A Quality Improvement Plan is a SMART.





SMART Goals

Specific

- What will happen when you complete/finish the goal?
- How will you complete/finish the goal?
- Why should you complete/finish the goal?

Measurable

- Increased child engagement when using Pre-K fine motor materials
- Less fighting over too few Pre-K fine motor materials





SMART Goals (continued)

Achievable

 Do you have the necessary knowledge, skills, abilities and resources to complete/finish this goal?

Relevant

- What is the reason for the goal?
- What is the purpose of the goal?
- What is the benefit of completing/finishing the goal?



SMART Goals (continued)

Time-bound

- Does each action step have a date that it will be completed/finished?
- Does the goal have a date that it will be completed/finished?





Quality Improvement Plans: Expectations

- At least 3 QIP goals focusing on an element of the QRIS matrix that the site has identified as an area they would like to improve.
- At least one QIP goal must refer to the rating report result and recommendations as the information used to generate a QIP.
- QIP narratives must tie with how quality ratings will be improved.
- Consist of at least 4 action steps per goal.
- Identify due dates and responsible person(s).
 - Ongoing updates on QIP Progress.
